Morrisville and Elmore 8th grade parents: You will receive a letter from your local school district with a school-choice enrollment application in the mail shortly. You can also access the application at this link: www.morrisville.org. Contact Sheila Jones at sheila.jones@lssuvt.org if you do not receive one. Parents in other school districts: Please contact your local public high school right away if you are interested in the state's school-choice lottery for your 8th grader to be considered at another public school outside of your residency district. Call them NOW to confirm their timeline of application submission since applications may be closing shortly.

Lamoille County Nature Center Summer Camp Programs 2019 – Information about their summer programs is displayed on our bulletin board at the front entrance to school. Camps are as follows:

Forest Fairy Camp – July 8 through 12 from 8am-12noon (ages 4-5) and the cost is \$120/members and \$135 non-members. Creature Tales Story Camp – July 15 through 19 from 9am-3pm (ages 5-8) and the cost is \$175/members and \$200 non-members.
