Part One:

Part Two:

- Interview an individual from your community who can tell you about your favorite location.
- Take his/her picture, if he/she agrees.
- Complete "Interview Graphic Organizer" form below.

Part Three

Synthesize your research and information!

- Create a Google slides presentation about your favorite place.
 - Presentation must be at least 10 slides and can certainly be more!
 - Be sure to include:
 - Why is it your favorite place?
 - The physical landscape of the area (topography)
 - The photographs you have taken
 - Old photographs of the area
 - Research
 - Interview
 - As always grammar and spelling count as well as creativity!
